

## Open Network for Digital Commerce (ONDC)



### ❖ Context

- The Union government plans to launch the Open Network for Digital Commerce (ONDC) this year, aiming to democratize e-commerce and offer alternatives to proprietary e-commerce platforms.

### ❖ What is the ONDC?

- The government wants to change the fundamental structure of the e-commerce market from the current “platform-centric model to an open-network model”.
- The ONDC is modelled after the Unified Payments Interface (UPI) project which is seen as a success by many.
- The UPI project allows people to send or receive money irrespective of the payment platforms on which they are registered.
- Similarly, the government wants to ensure that buyers and sellers of goods in the e-commerce market can transact regardless of the platforms on which they are registered.
- So under ONDC, a buyer registered on Amazon, for example, may directly purchase goods from a seller who sells on Flipkart.
- To make such transactions a reality, the government has ordered companies to list themselves on the ONDC.

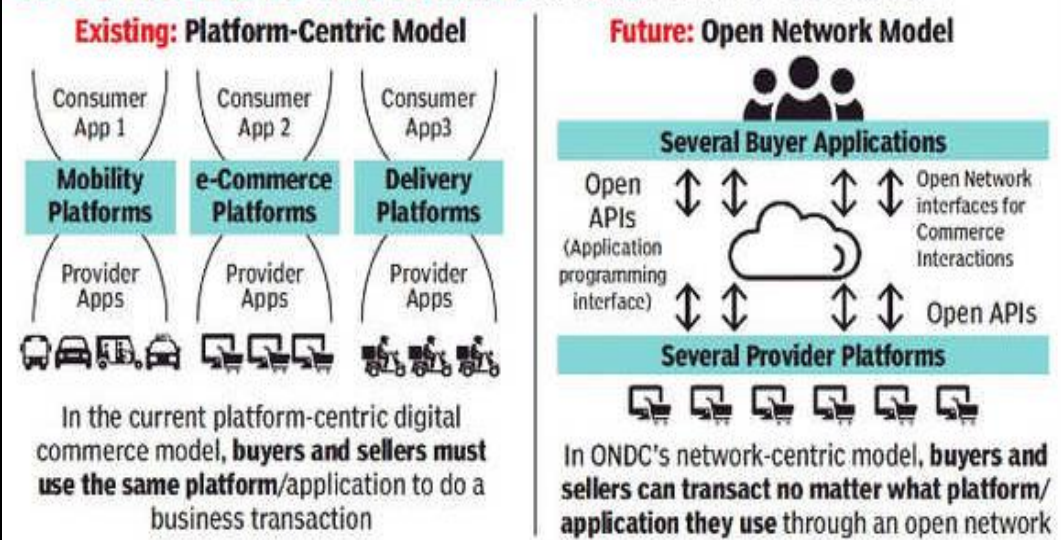
### ❖ Why is the Centre pushing for it?

- **End domination:** The government believes that the ONDC will put an end to the domination of the e-commerce market by a few large platforms.
- It says that the e-commerce market is currently broken into “silos” operated & dominated by private platforms.
- Amazon and Flipkart, for instance, have been accused of promoting certain seller entities in which they hold indirect stakes.

### ❖ Significance:

- With an open network like ONDC that connects buyers and sellers across platforms, the government hopes to **level the playing field** and make private platforms redundant.

### GOVT HOPES TO REPLICATE UPI MODEL'S SUCCESS



**ONDC's core** aim is to enable e-commerce for small sellers and businesses.

**Parallels have** been drawn with UPI, meaning it could do for e-commerce what UPI did for digital payments.

**CUSTOMERS CAN ACCESS SELLERS ON ONDC THROUGH ANY APP THAT IS INTEGRATED WITH THE NETWORK.**

**Sellers will** handle deliveries through tie-ups with logistics firm.

**ONDC will** also have embedded services like ledgers and a payment processor.

## Ganga's Geo-Tagged Drains

### ❖ Context

- All drains carrying waste from villages along the Ganga river will be geo-tagged to prevent solid waste from entering the river.



### ❖ Key Highlights:

- The information about the geo-tagged drains will be shared with **urban local bodies, the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs**, and the rural Swachh Bharat Mission (G) to take immediate action.
- The construction of a tunnel in **Uttarkashi, Uttarakhand**, has led to the dumping of debris along the Ganga river banks, causing an increase in solid waste pollution in the river water.
- Solid waste is being dumped in various locations along the Ganga river banks, which is finding its way into the river water.
- The presence of solid waste in the river water is causing difficulties in treating wastewater at **sewage treatment plants (STPs)**.
- The Secretary of the Ministry of Jal Shakti suggested using funds from AMRUT 2.0 to install screens and prevent solid waste from entering the river water.

### ❖ What is Geotagging?

- Geo-tagging refers to the process of adding **geographic metadata, such as coordinates or location information**, to various forms of media, including photographs, videos, or textual data.
- It enables the precise identification and association of a specific geographical location with the media content.
- Geo-tagging typically utilizes **Global Positioning System (GPS)** technology or other location-based services to determine the exact coordinates of a particular point of interest.
- These coordinates are then embedded or linked to the media, allowing it to be geographically referenced.

## Defence Production

### ❖ Context

- India has announced that the value of defence production in the country has crossed ₹1 lakh crore for the first time, indicating significant growth in the sector.



### ❖ Key Highlights:

- In the financial year 2022-23, the value of defence production reached **₹1,06,800 crore**, compared to **₹95,000 crore in the previous year** and ₹54,951 crore five years ago.
- India has focused on the defence manufacturing sector, implementing measures such as
  - import bans,
  - a separate budget for domestic procurement,
  - increased foreign direct investment,
  - and improved ease of doing business.
- The government's policies have led to **increased participation of industries**, including micro, small & medium enterprises (MSMEs) and start-ups, resulting in a significant rise in defence licenses issued.
- The **corporatisation of the Ordnance Factory Board (OFB)** in 2021 has also contributed to boosting defence production **efficiency and competitiveness**.
- India's focus extends to boosting defence exports, which have seen significant growth in recent years, with **military hardware** exports reaching a record high of ₹15,920 crore in FY 2022-23.

- India is exporting a range of weapons and systems to numerous countries, including **missiles, artillery guns, rockets, vehicles, radars, surveillance systems, and ammunition.**



## Methamphetamine

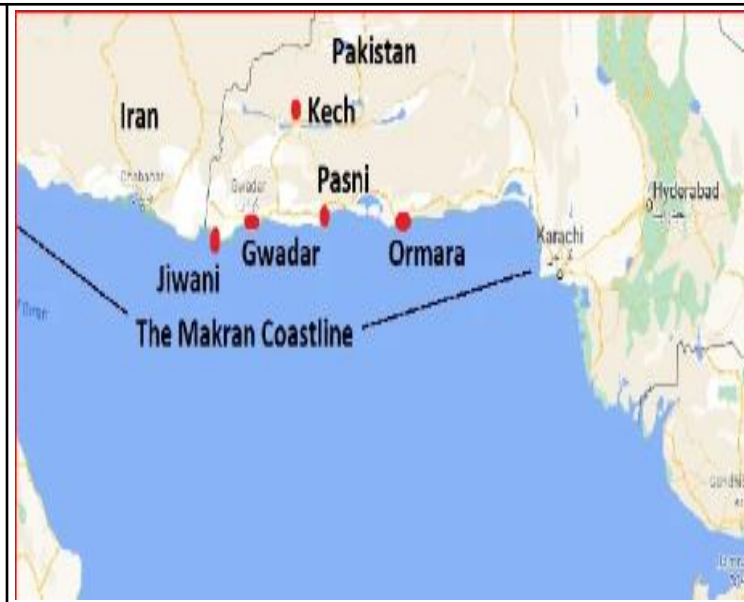
### ❖ Context

- The Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) and the Indian Navy conducted a joint operation off the Kerala coast.
- The operation resulted in the seizure of **approximately 2,500 kg** of methamphetamine, valued at around ₹15,000 crore.



### ❖ Key Highlights:

- Methamphetamine, commonly known as meth, is a highly addictive central nervous system stimulant drug.
- It belongs to the **amphetamine class of drugs** and is chemically similar to **amphetamine**.
- Methamphetamine is typically **produced in illegal laboratories** and comes in the form of a white crystalline powder that can be **snorted, smoked, injected, or taken orally**.
- This drug seizure is claimed to be the largest ever in terms of **monetary value** by any anti-drug enforcement agency in India.
- The drugs originated in Pakistan and were loaded onto a mother ship from the **Makran coast**. The operation is part of **Operation Samudragupt**, aiming to eliminate maritime drug trafficking in the Indian Ocean region.



## News in Between the Lines

### Wetland Authority of Delhi

### ❖ Context

- The Wetland Authority of Delhi (WAD) has received requests from the Delhi Development Authority (DDA) to delete 232 waterbodies, accounting for **22.2% of the total 1,045 waterbodies in its records**.

### ❖ Key Highlights:

- Requests for deletion are made by some of the 16 agencies that own waterbodies in the city, citing reasons such as **encroachment or drying up**.
- The WAD has prepared "brief documents" for 710 waterbodies, while the rest are either encroached upon or their owners are yet to be identified.

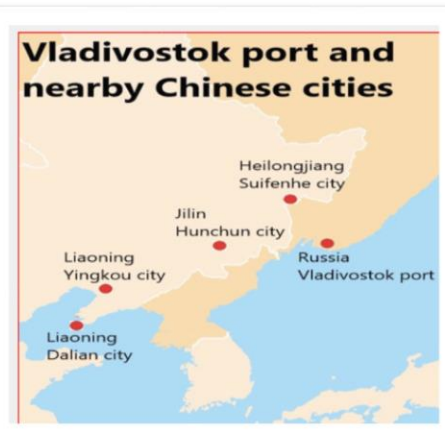
### Face to Face Centres





- The number of waterbodies in Delhi has significantly decreased over the years, with a 1997 survey indicating over 1,000 waterbodies and the current count being less than 700.
- The Najafgarh lake, for example, has shrunk from 80 sq. km in 1883 to just 5 sq. km at present.
- **Wetlands play** a crucial role in :
  - supporting diverse plant and animal life,
  - mitigating urban flooding,
  - purifying and storing water,
  - recharging groundwater,
  - controlling erosion,
  - and regulating microclimate.

## Vladivostok Port



### ❖ Context

- China and Russia have reached an agreement to enhance economic cooperation and strengthen bilateral ties.

### ❖ Key Highlights:

- The agreement focuses on utilizing the Russian port of **Vladivostok as a transit hub** for domestic shipments from China, aiming to reduce transport costs and support the revitalization of Northeast China's industrial base.
- China has designated **Vladivostok as a transit hub** for its domestic shipments, streamlining the transport process and reducing costs.
- The agreement provides China with a **shorter and more cost-effective route** for transporting goods from its northeastern region to Zhejiang Province, resulting in substantial cost savings.
- The agreement is set to take effect in June 2023, positioning Vladivostok as a domestic port for Jilin Province and facilitating seamless transportation of goods without tariffs or taxes.
- This arrangement aligns with China's national strategic plan to revitalize its industrial base in Northeast China, promoting cross-border trade, economic growth, and strengthening ties between China and Russia.
- Vladivostok, located in the Primorsky Krai region, serves as the **administrative center and is strategically** located around the **Golden Horn Bay**, approximately 45 kilometers from the China-Russia border.

## Patch Reporting App



### ❖ Context

- The Chief Minister of Uttarakhand recently inaugurated the "**Patch Reporting App**" developed by the **Public Works Department** to address the issue of potholes on the state's roads.

### ❖ Key Highlights:

- The user-friendly app empowers individuals to report **potholes and monitor** the actions taken to make Uttarakhand's roads safe and pothole-free.
- The app enhances **accountability and efficiency by providing** a convenient platform for citizens to register complaints and provide detailed information, including photographs of the potholes.
- It ensures transparency by offering regular **updates on the actions** taken to resolve the **complaints, accompanied by visual evidence**.
- The app has an interactive and location-based design that displays **precise location information** using latitude and longitude coordinates, enabling prompt action by the Public Works Department.
- Both complainants and higher-ranking officials receive **comprehensive details** of the work done, accompanied by **photographs, ensuring transparency and accountability**.

### ❖ Significance:

- The Patch Reporting App aims to engage the public and promote road safety by actively involving citizens in contributing to the **maintenance of road infrastructure**.
- It serves as a vital channel for reporting potholes on roads managed by the Public Works Department in Uttarakhand.

## Gaganyaan



### ❖ Context

- Indigenously Developed Parachutes for India's **Gaganyaan Programme** to Undergo Fitment Tests.

### ❖ Key Highlights:

- These parachutes are being designed to ensure the safe return of the capsule **carrying astronauts during the Gaganyaan mission.**
- The parachutes will undergo fitment tests at an **Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO)** facility in Bengaluru.
- The parachute system consists of 10 parachutes, each serving a specific purpose during the descent of the crew module.
- The sequence of deployment includes **apex cover separation parachutes**, drogue parachutes for stabilization, pilot parachutes for extraction, and main parachutes for a safe landing.

### ❖ Significance:

- The success of such demonstrations will determine the readiness for an unmanned mission. The **Test Vehicle Demonstration (TVD-1)** flight will mark a significant milestone toward the realization of India's **ambitious Gaganyaan program.**

## Calcium-41



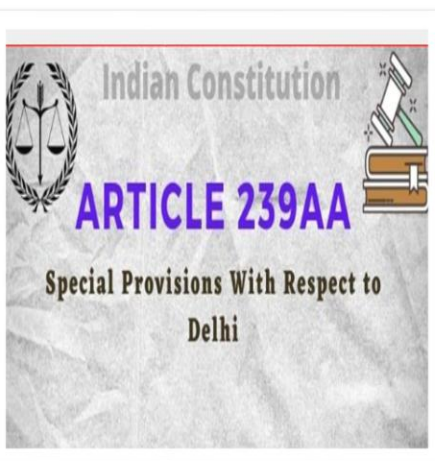
### ❖ Context

- Calcium-41 has been suggested as a **new tool for radiometric dating.**

### ❖ Key Highlights:

- Calcium-41 has a half-life of about **1.04 × 10<sup>5</sup> years**, which is significantly longer than the **half-life of Carbon-14 (5730 years).**
- The longer half-life allows calcium-41 to be used for dating geological events that occurred within the last few hundred thousand years, whereas Carbon-14 is limited to dating materials up to **about 50,000 years old.**
- The nucleus of **calcium-41 contains 20 protons and 21 neutrons**, giving it a mass number of 41.
- By studying the distribution and movement of calcium-41, researchers can gain insights into various processes, such as **bone formation, calcium transport, and calcium dynamics in marine and terrestrial systems.**

## Article 239AA



### ❖ Context

- The Centre has issued an ordinance granting extended powers to the **Delhi Lieutenant Governor**, including authority over the **transfer and appointment of bureaucrats in the capital.**

### ❖ Key Highlights:

- The Ordinance is **aimed** at nullifying the effect of the **CJI DY Chandrachud-led Constitution Bench's verdict**, which gave the **Delhi government power over administrative services in the capital.**

### ❖ What is Article 239AA of the Constitution?

- Inserted into the Constitution by the **69th Amendment Act, 1991**, Article 239AA conferred **special status on Delhi** following the recommendations of the **S Balakrishnan Committee**. According to this provision, the **NCT of Delhi will have an administrator and a Legislative Assembly.**
- The **Legislative Assembly of Delhi** has the authority to **make laws for the city, except in matters related to police, public order, and land.**

### ❖ Supreme Court Judgments:

- In a **majority ruling in 2018**, the court held that while Delhi cannot be granted statehood, the concept of federalism still applies to it.
- The court stated that **Article 239AA provides** for a representative form of government for Delhi, with a directly elected Legislative Assembly and legislative powers over State and Concurrent List matters.
- The **Lieutenant Governor (LG)** is required to act on the aid and advice of the Council of Ministers, except in exceptional circumstances where the matter is referred to the President for a decision.
